



**BTOG THORACIC ONCOLOGY COURSE 2012**  
**Monday 12<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> March 2012**  
**Glenfield Hospital, Leicester**

**COURSE AIMS:** The aim is to provide participants with an overview of the current diagnosis, staging and management of lung cancer and mesothelioma with state-of-the art presentations and case based group seminars from recognised experts.

**COURSE DELEGATES:** The courses are aimed at trainees, newly appointed consultants, specialist registrars, specialist and other nurses and allied health professionals in respiratory medicine, thoracic surgery, clinical and medical oncology and palliative care. Delegates can attend one day or both days. A few places are available for industry attendees.

**Parking** is available in designated Pay & Display car parks at Glenfield Hospital. The charge will be between £6 and £8 per day. Change machines are situated in the main reception area and at South Entrance.

**By train:** The railway station in Leicester is close to the city centre and approximately four miles from Glenfield Hospital. Timetables and ticket information can be obtained from the National Rail Enquiries at [www.nationalrail.co.uk](http://www.nationalrail.co.uk).

A hospital shuttle bus departs from the railway station every 30 minutes. A timetable can be obtained from <http://www.leicestershospitals.nhs.uk/patients/getting-to-hospital/bus-travel/hospital-hopper-bus/>

The bus stop is on an 'island' between several lanes of traffic, and a pelican crossing immediately outside the station will take you to the right place. The bus stop lists 'UHL' as one of the services that stop there. To get to Glenfield, the destination will be 'Beaumont Centre'. To return to the railway station, you will need to catch the shuttle going to 'Hamilton Centre'. A day ticket will cost £1.50. Alternatively, taxis are readily available at the station and the journey to Glenfield will take approximately 20 minutes in normal traffic.

**By air:** The nearest airport is East Midlands ([www.eastmidlandsairport.com](http://www.eastmidlandsairport.com)). A taxi from the airport will take approximately 30 minutes.
