Biographies

Mr John Edwards is a Consultant Thoracic Surgeon, Sheffield Teaching Hospitals. Clinical interests include all forms of surgery for lung cancer and malignant mesothelioma, thoracic trauma, chest wall deformities (Nuss, Ravitch, Schulz-Drost Elastic Stable Repair), lung volume reduction (VATS and Endobronchial), endoscopic thoracic sympathectomy. I have a major research interest in mesothelioma, covering basic science research as well as surgical and oncological management. I perform regularly Extended Pleurectomy/Decortication and VATS Partial Pleurectomy. I am committed to trials of surgery for mesothelioma and receive referrals from all parts of the UK. I am passionate about the access of patients and carers to appropriate information and advice about treatment choices.

Prof Corinne Faivre-Finn is an Honorary Consultant Oncologist and a Professor of Thoracic Radiation Oncology at The University of Manchester with an interest in lung cancer. She trained in Paris until 1998 and took a consultant post at The Christie in 2001. She was appointed as Professor of Thoracic Radiation Oncology at the University of Manchester in 2015. Prof Faivre-Finn is an active member of several national and international research committees.

Dr Tom Newsom-Davis is a consultant in medical oncology at Chelsea and Westminster Hospital, London, where he specialises in thoracic malignancies. He has been a member of the BTOG Steering Committee for the past 2 years, and until recently was part of the National Cancer Research Institute Lung Group and led the RM Partners Cancer Vanguard lung pathway. Dr Newsom-Davis is actively involved in clinical research and has presented his work at a number of national and international meetings. He has been an invited lecturer for various organisations including BTOG, the Royal College of Physicians, International Association for the Study of Lung Cancer, British Medical Association and the Association of Cancer Physicians. In 2015, his work was awarded the Macmillan Innovation Excellence Award.

Professor Sanjay Popat is Consultant Thoracic Medical Oncologist at the Royal Marsden Hospital and Professor of Thoracic Oncology at the Institute of Cancer Research. Professor Popat has published in the fields of genetics, therapeutic biomarkers and medical oncology. He has been awarded nationally and internationally competitive prizes for his research, in addition to 4 research fellowships. He has published over 150 papers and is an active member of the EORTC Lung Group, has been elected to the Foundation Council of ETOP and is past chair of the UK NCRI Lung Cancer CSG Advanced Diseases Subgroup. Professor Popat joined the BTOG Steering Committee in 2010 and was elected Chair of the Steering Committee in 2013.
